Intra-European Fellowships (IEF)

The Intra-European Fellowship aims at enhancing the trans-national mobility of experienced researchers of any nationality currently active in Europe. The financial EU contribution enables researchers to move to another EU Member State (MS) or Associated Country (AC) for diversifying their scientific knowledge and getting complementary skills. The host institution can be a public or a private organisation active in research. Alike to the other Marie Curie Actions, the IEF follows a bottom-up approach, i.e. the research project is chosen freely by the applicant in cooperation with his/her supervisor at the host organisation.

Proposal preparation:

- Eligible researcher, in cooperation with his/her host organisation in an EU Member State or Associated country (university, independent research institution, industry, etc)
- Contracts will be signed between the European Commission and the host organisation

Eligible Researchers:

- Experienced researchers in possession of a PhD or at least 4 years of research experience
- Researchers of any nationality who must comply with the mobility rule: They must move from an MS or AC to another MS or AC and cannot have resided or carried out their main activity in the country of their host organisation for more than 12 months in the past 3 years
- Researchers will establish a Career Development Plan together with their supervisor in order to shape an individual training programme and get support in their professional development
