Place of the Participant Portal in EU's Research communication media (1/2)

The FP7 (7th Framework Programme for Research and Technological Development) is the EU's main instrument for funding research.

3 Internet portals related to the FP7 are currently used:

- RESEARCH on EUROPA → policy context
- PARTICIPANT PORTAL → interactions with participants
- CORDIS → dissemination of FP7 results

There is an ongoing reorganisation of the division of tasks in these portals until end 2012 to offer better services.

The Participant Portal is the single entry point for the electronic administration of EU-funded research and innovation projects.

It hosts services for managing proposals and projects throughout their lifecycle.







Why the Participant Portal?

This unique entry point for the grant-related interactions with the European Commission or Agencies is based on:

- single sign-on approach (ECAS)
- role-based authorisation (IAM)

The result is a **personalised** and **secure** access to the services on the Participant Portal; it ensures **homogeneity**, **transparency** and a **better service integration** for grant management.





What is the scope of the Participant Portal?

Currently the portal covers actions under the FP7:

- Cooperation
- Ideas (ERC)
- People (Marie Curie)
- Capacities
- Euratom


In the future, other programmes will be included within the Participant Portal as well:

Forthcoming functionalities

- Expert evaluators will be able to manage the administrative details related to their work as peer reviewers.
- The currently separate electronic proposal submission system will be replaced by a new system integrated in the portal.
- Direct access to EP7 related information and documentation.

How does it work?



While some basic functions are available for anonymous users, the core functions of project management are only available to registered users. If you are a registered user you can use the login button.



After login, the actual homepage will be replaced by a new one displaying all the processes your user profile can access.



On that new page, the blue arrows are the processes that are authorised for your profile and they will give you access to several lists, like the list of organisations, projects, roles of your project etc.



When you go into the details of an organisation. project, role etc... a new contextual menu will guide you through the additional actions.






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Use the search facility to check if an organisation has already a PIC. You can check if an organisation has already a PIC here If you do not find a pic for your organisation you have to first register as ECAS user here.

With your ECAS password you can register your organisation here.

The steps to register your organisation are:

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STEP 2: Self-Register your organisation in PP

Register your organisation using your ECAS account details. After providing all the necessary details, press the [CONFIRM] button to submit your registration information to the Central Validation Team (CVT). If you wish to suspend the registration process at any point, the data entered may be saved as a draft by clicking the [Save Draft] button. You may then resume your registration at any

- STEP 3: Modify your self Registration
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If you saved your data as draft, it is still possible to modify or delete your self-registration.

STEP 3b.

If you have already submitted your registration and if CVT has not started the verification process that will eventually lead to the appointment of a Legal Entity Appointed Representative (LEAR), it is still possible to modify your self-registration and/or upload additional documents

STEP 3c.

If CVT has already started the verification process, you can no longer modify your self-registration data but you are still able to upload additional documents

After identification, the CVT begins a verification process that will eventually lead to the appointment of a Legal Entity Appointed Representative (LEAR). During this period, the data that you have declared about your organisation can no longer be modified. You will however still be able to upload up to 10 Mb of additional supporting documents. Once uploaded, these documents cannot be withdrawn or modified, except by the validated LEAR.

When your data has been validated by the CVT, you, as self registrant, will no longer be able to edit the data related to your organisation. From this point on, the organisation data may be maintained only by the LEAR.
