## Fulbright Visiting Professor at the University of Minnesota

### Department of Art and the Center for Austrian Studies 2014-2015

The Austrian-American Educational Commission (Fulbright Commission) and the College of Liberal Arts at the University of Minnesota are pleased to request applications for a visiting professorship for an Austrian scholar at the University of Minnesota for the academic year 2014-2015. The Fulbright Visiting Professor for 2014-2015 will be affiliated with the Center for Austrian Studies, an interdisciplinary and interdepartmental research facility for Austrian, Habsburg, and Central European studies established in 1977 as a bicentennial gift of the people and government of Austria to the United States, and the Department of Art in the College of Liberal Arts.

This collaboration is based on a memorandum of understanding concluded by the Austrian Fulbright Commission and the College of Liberal Arts in 2001 and renewed in 2010. This visiting professorship was conceived to rotate among departments in the College of Liberal Arts affiliated with the Center for Austrian Studies.

### Description

The Department of Art (<http://art.umn.edu/>) invites applications from scholars whose work is central to the department's creative and teaching missions. The department is particularly interested in artist/educators willing to offer special workshops and seminars in the areas of printmaking, painting and drawing, or digital and experimental media.

The Fulbright professor will teach one advanced undergraduate or beginning graduate course (please see departmental course listings on the website) during the semester in residence of fall 2014 or spring 2015. The Fulbright Visiting Professor will be expected to advise students seeking expertise from the visitor's field of specialization and to deliver one public lecture under the auspices of the Center for Austrian Studies and the relevant department. This appointment will provide the Fulbright Visiting Professor with ample opportunities for research, creative and scholarly collaborations.
