innovation cooperation between main EU and third country actors and to enhance uptake of research results on subjects of mutual interest in the areas of climate action, resource efficiency and raw materials, as described in the Commission proposal for Horizon 2020. Targeted regions are: Latin America, ASEAN, the Mediterranean and

the Black Sea, the North Atlantic. Consortia should include a sufficient number of eligible ICPC country partners or other

international partners from the target regions to ensure adequate scale and scope of cooperation. Priority will be given to consortia which can ensure contacts with and sufficient additional financial commitment from research-related regional structures and/or national authorities or major research institutes in the region.
