



PEOPLE - MARIE CURIE ACTIONS International Outgoing Fellowships (IOF)

The International Outgoing Fellowship enables researchers currently active in an EU Member State or Associated Country to be trained and acquire new knowledge & experience in a third country (e.g. USA, Canada, China, India, Brazil, etc.). IOF involves firstly an outgoing phase followed by a mandatory return phase in Europe in the frame of a coherent research and training programme. Alike to the other Marie Curie Actions, the IOF follows a bottom-up approach, i.e. the research project is chosen freely by the applicant in cooperation with his/her supervisor at the host organisation.

Proposal preparation:

- Eligible researchers, in cooperation with their return host organisation in an EU Member State or Associated country (university, independent research institution, company, etc.) and the outgoing host institution.
- Contracts will be signed between the European Commission and the return-host organisation in Europe.

Eligible Researchers:

- Experience researchers in possession of a PhD or with at least 4 years of research experience
- Nationals of an EU Member State (MS) or Associated Country (AC). Third country nationals who have been residing and carrying out their main activity in an MS or AC for at least 5 years
- Researchers must comply with the mobility rule and move from an MS or AC to a third country (outside Europe)
