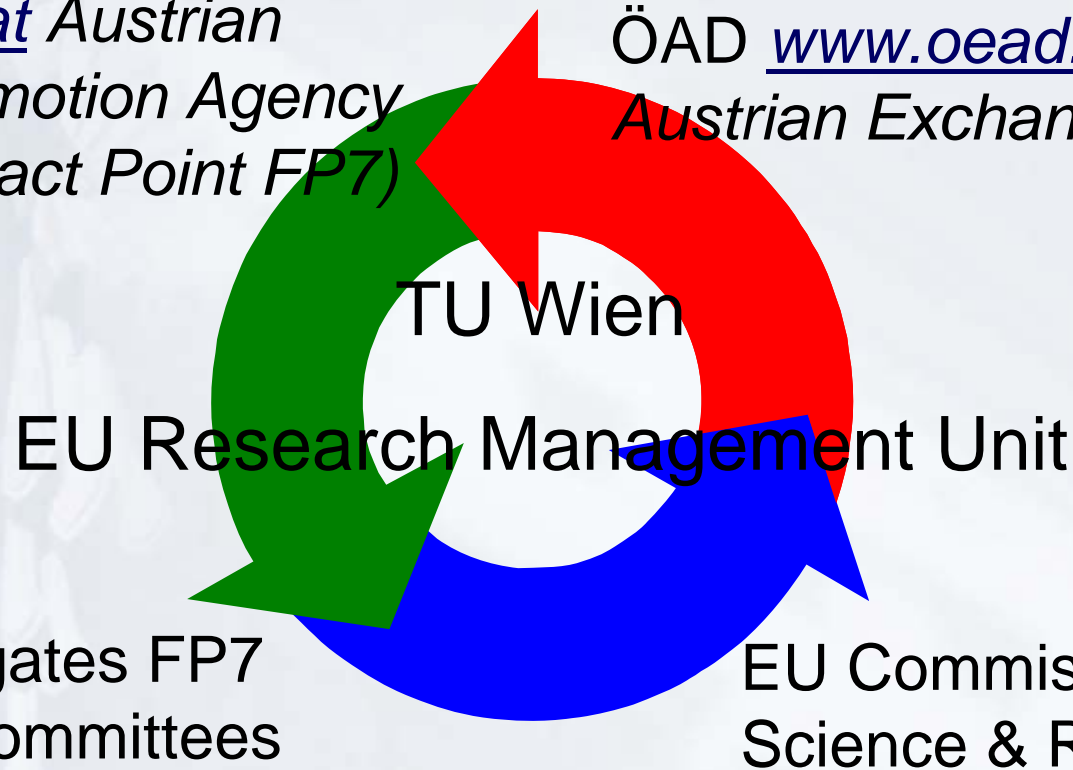
## Vienna University of Technology

- EU research mobility: Marie Curie actions, ERA-MORE initiative.

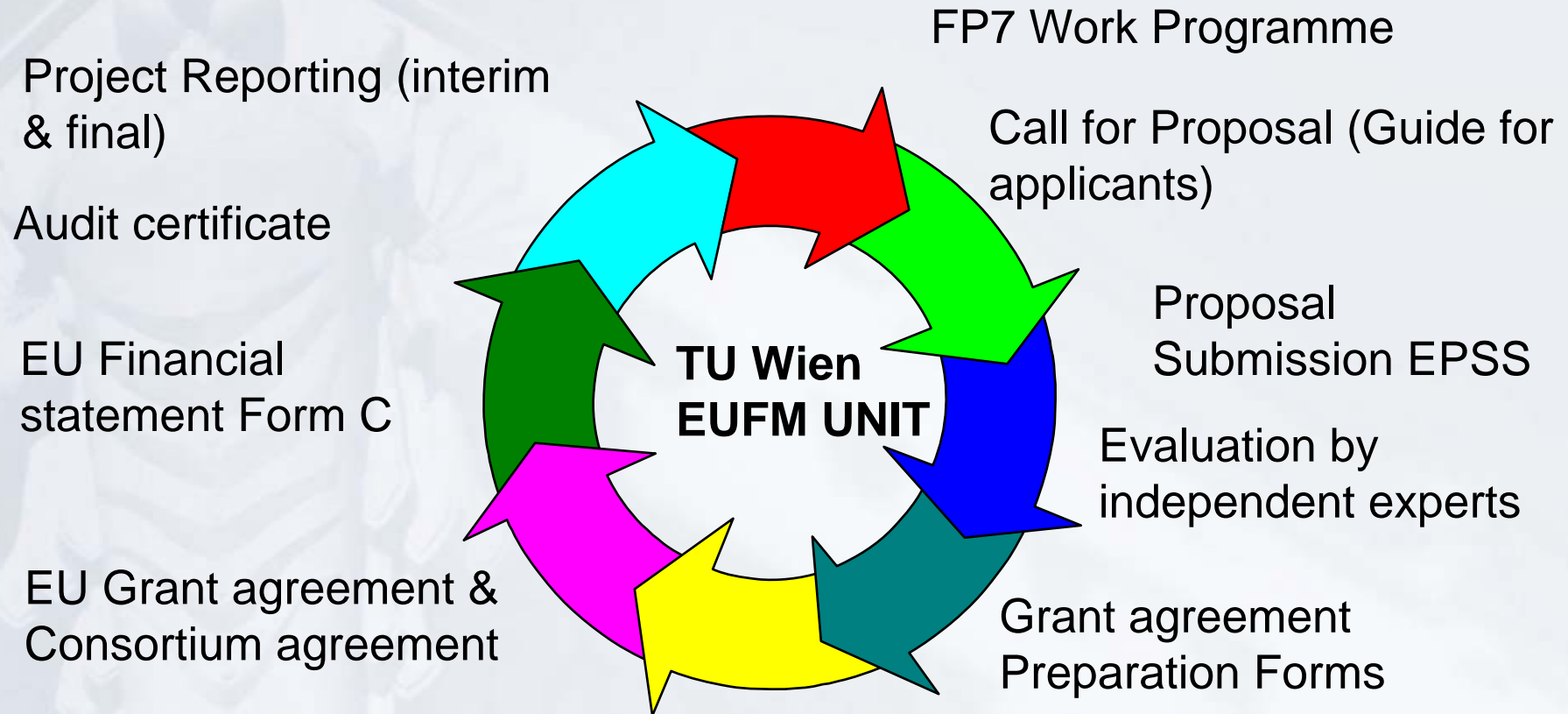
# International Project Development

- Identify the appropriate research area;
- Create a complementary consortium;
- Define the roles of participants (coordinator, beneficiary and subcontractor);
- Calculate the total project costs;
- Search for public funding.

# EU Project Management Support

- FP7 Individual Proposal Consultings (calls, administrative forms, financial and legal aspects);
- FP7 Project Management (financial statements, auditing and legal documents);
- EU Project Monitoring and Statistics.

## The EU Project Life Cycle

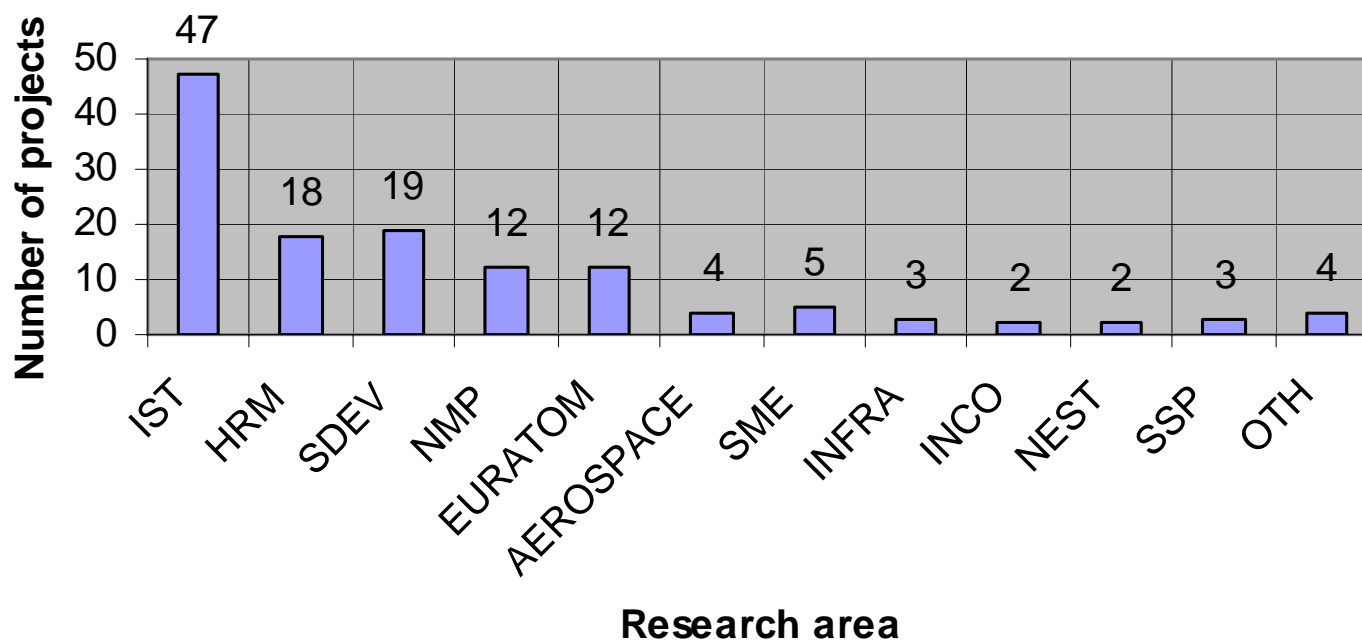


## Funds for International Co-operation in Science & Technology

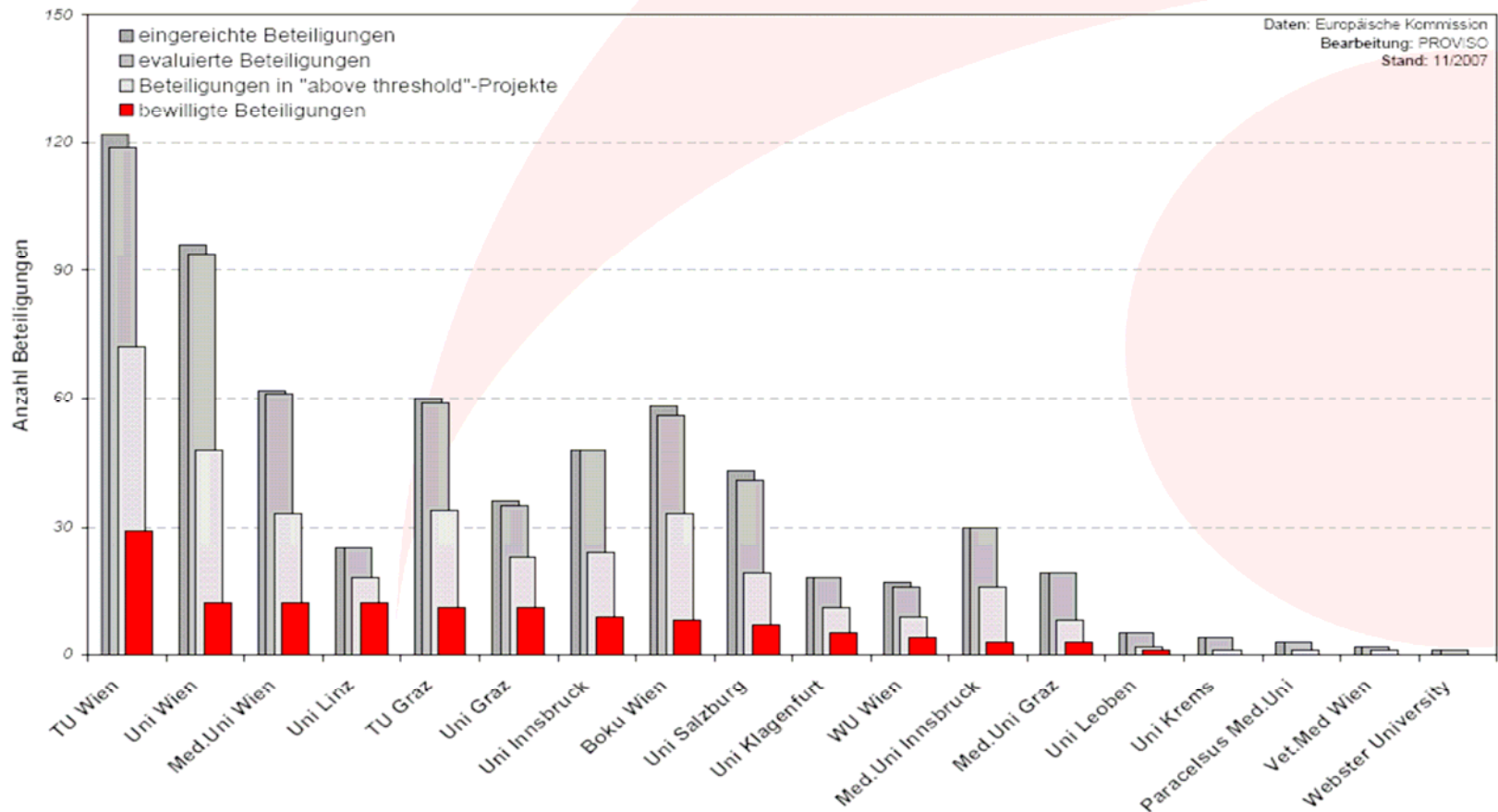
