Indicative evaluation and contractual timetable

Evaluations are expected to be carried out during the month of September 2008. It is expected that the grant agreement negotiations for the shortlisted proposals will be open in November 2008.

Particular requirements for participation, evaluation and implementation

For this call, the minimum number of participating legal entities required, for the funding scheme Coordination and Support Action (Supporting) is as follows: at least 10 independent legal entities, established in at least 10 different Member States or Associated Countries.

These participation criteria are also criteria for the eligibility of the proposal.

The forms of grant which will be offered and the maximum reimbursement rates are specified in Annex 3 to the Capacities work programme.
