




The indicative breakdown (€ million) of FP7

Facts and opportunities

The socio-economic sciences and humanities programme ...

- is with a total budget of € 610 Million (FP7) the biggest R&D programme in SSH worldwide;
- has supported more than <u>350 projects and 3500 research</u> organisations between 2002 and 2011 (FP6 & FP7).

15% of the ERC budget is being spent for Social Sciences and Humanities research;

A number of Social Sciences and Humanities <u>research</u> <u>infrastructures</u> are being supported under FP7, such as the European Social Survey and the Survey on Healthy Ageing and Retirement in Europe (SHARE).

Strategy for 2013

- → Strong commitment to the implementation of policies in line with Europe 2020 or other initiatives (e.g. citizenship or external affairs) related to the EU policy agenda.
- → Strong commitment to the implementation of the Innovation Union Flagship in areas where the programme has a clear added-value, e.g. social innovation, innovation policy, foresight.
- → Building a bridge to HORIZON 2020.

New calls for proposals published on 10 July 2012:

FP7-SSH-2013-1 (large-scale projects = 4-5 M€)

FP7-SSH-2013-2 (small-medium projects < 2.5 M€)

(CSA < 1.5 M€)

Deadline: 31 January 2013 at 17:00 (Brussels time)

Total budget for these calls: 106 M€

FP7-ERANET-PLUS (6 M€)

Deadline: 28 February 2013 at 17:00 (Brussels time)

Last but not least ...some advice

- Read the Work Programme and the Guide for Applicants carefully!
- Look at previous successful EU projects
- Think and act as a "Coordinator" or as a "Partner"
- Take the necessary time for drafting the proposal and establish the appropriate consortium (what other -than researchers- type of participants could be useful to fullfill the requirements of the call text (stakeholders; practitioners; users; networks...))?
- Take sufficient time for ALL THREE evaluation criteria!
- Ask the opinion of your colleagues
- Be in touch with your NCP
- Respect the deadline (31/1/2013 at 17:00 CET)
