- Institutions can be involved in a Partnership project with running Erasmus
  Mundus Masters Courses in order to foster international cooperation, develop

  can submit an Erasmus Mundus Action 3 Project.

It supports activities that improve the profile, the visibility and the accessibility of European higher education as well as issues crucial to the internationalisation of higher education, such as the mutual recognition of qualifications with third countries.

**Policy-oriented measures**, addressing comparative higher education and vocational training issues, and promoting dialogue on recognition of qualifications and accreditations

At least two EU institutions from different EU-Member States and at least one US institution form a project consortium.

The next call for proposals is envisaged for 2007.
