

Possibilities for EU-US Cooperation in Higher Education within EU Programmes

ERASMUS MUNDUS <http://europa.eu.int/erasmus-mundus>

- Students can apply for participation in high level ERASMUS MUNDUS Masters Courses and receive ERASMUS MUNDUS scholarships. Students apply directly to the Erasmus Mundus Masters Course of their interest. http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/mundus/projects/index_en.html
- Scholars can apply for participation (teaching and research) in ERASMUS MUNDUS Masters Courses. Scholarships are available. Scholars apply directly to the Erasmus Mundus Masters Course of their interest. http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/mundus/projects/index_en.html
- Institutions can be involved in a Partnership project with running Erasmus Mundus Masters Courses in order to foster international cooperation, develop course material, exchange students, etc. Institutions contact directly to the Erasmus Mundus Masters Course of their interest. The European consortium can submit an Erasmus Mundus Action 3 Project. http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/mundus/projects/index_en.html
- Institutions can be project partner in Erasmus Mundus Action 4 projects. Under this Action Erasmus Mundus supports projects aimed at enhancing the attractiveness of and the interest in European higher education. It supports activities that improve the profile, the visibility and the accessibility of European higher education as well as issues crucial to the internationalisation of higher education, such as the mutual recognition of qualifications with third countries.

At least two EU institutions from different EU-Member States and at least one US institution form a project consortium.
